She runs a staff of 15 members from the GCPL Administrative Center.

Ms. Doyle joins GCPL with an extensive background in library service. In her most recent position, she was a Technical Processing Librarian at Rodman Public Library in Alliance, Ohio. She served at Cuyahoga County Public Library as the Catalog Department Manager, Cataloging Supervisor, Music Supervisor and Public Services Librarian over a span of 24 years. She also has library experience at Case Western Reserve University's Kulas Music Library, and at Youngstown Public Library as well. She holds a Master's degree in Library Science from Kent State University. Most of her service is in public libraries but she also has experience in academic libraries, special collections and with organizing personal libraries.

"Georgianne's understanding of collection development and processing is impressive," says GCPL Director Deborah F. O'Connor. "Not only does she demonstrate a deep knowledge of cataloging and collection development, she's also in tune with her staff. She works closely with personnel in our buildings and wants to continue building a dynamic collection that appeals to our patrons' varied interests.
