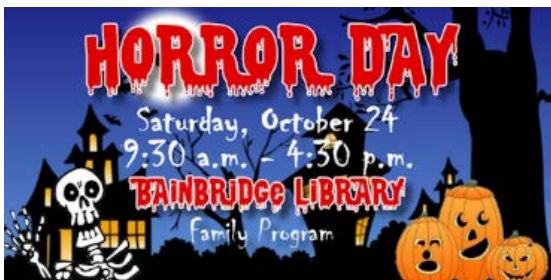
- 1 p.m.                   Scream contest. Can you belt out a good, old-fashioned scream?
