Writers will learn how to realize their passion through time management and a positive mindset. As Adams says, "Today is the first day of the rest of your writing life. Find out the difference between you and successful writers. Then become one." Adams will be on hand to sell and sign books after the class.

Deanna R. Adams is an award-winning writer, essayist, speaker, and author of six books, both fiction and nonfiction. Her articles, essays, and stories have been published in a variety of newspapers and magazines, including an article on the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum for the *Encyclopedia of the Midwest*.

Her books include *Rock 'n' Roll and the Cleveland Connection* (Kent State University Press, 2002), *Confessions of a Not-So-Good Catholic Girl* (Infinity Publishing, 2008), *Cleveland's Rock and Roll Roots* (Arcadia Publishing, 2010), *Peggy Sue Got Pregnant* (Soul Mate Publishing, 2013), and *Scoundrels & Dreamers* (Soul Mate Publishing, 2014). Her latest book is *The Writer's GPS: A Guide to Writing & Selling Your Book*.
