Blog your way to a book with GCPL and Burton Public Library

Geauga County – Aug. 16, 2018 – Do you have a story to tell? Have you ever thought about blogging or writing a book? There’s never been a better time to get started or to dust off that literary project you’ve put on hold. Geauga County Public Library and Burton Public Library are launching a collaborative year-long writing program “blog your way to a book”, where we will discuss how you can go from a blogger to a published author in one year* (October 2018-2019).

Attend one of these introductory sessions to learn how to create your own blog and fill it with your stories. As you gradually build your blog, you’ll be creating what will become an actual book. The entire process takes about a year.

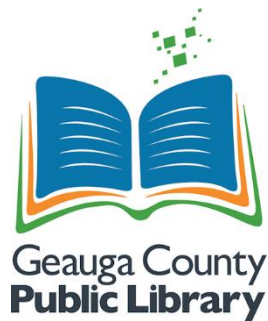

About the Geauga County Public Library

The Geauga County Public Library includes four full-service branches in Bainbridge, Chardon, Chesterland (Gauga West) and Middlefield; two library stations housed in schools in Newbury and Thompson; two Bookmobiles that serve rural areas and community centers; a Lobby Stop vehicle; a car for homebound patrons; and an administrative center where technical services, computer services, facilities and administrative functions reside. GCPL has more than 750,000 books and ebooks. The collection also contains more than 100,000 audio / video items and 400 research databases available through its website.
