#### **What is the “100 Book Challenge?”**

If you’ve been looking for a reason to read outside your comfort zone and expand your literary horizons, you need to take the GCPL 100 Book Challenge. Participants have two years to read 100 books from a list of about 300 titles that have been selected to induce discovery in all genres and styles. That’s about a book a week. Granted, it’s not for wimps. But, the prize is worth the effort.

Here’s how it works: Sign up for the challenge at any GCPL reference desk. Then, you will be able to “opt in” to the challenge inside your online library account where you can keep track of your progress. After you’ve read the book, visit the reference desk at your favorite GCPL location to answer a simple question about it to prove you read the book.

Complete the challenge, and receive a fleece GCPL jacket or vest from the combined Geauga County Library Foundation and libraries’ Friends’ groups that will allow you to show off your literary prowess with pride. #### **About the Geauga County Public Library**

The Geauga County Public Library includes four full-service branches in Bainbridge, Chardon, Chesterland (Geauga West) and Middlefield, two library stations housed in schools in Newbury and

Thompson, and a Mobile Services fleet that serves rural areas and community centers. Its administrative center is located in Chardon, where technical services, computer services, facilities and administrative functions reside. GCPL houses more than 750,000 books and digital books. The collection also contains more than 100,000 audio / video items. About 75 research databases are available via its website. GCPL is a member of the Clevnet consortium, giving patrons access to more than 12 million items.
