Bond issue 2017: Meet GCPL Director Ed Worso for a townhall conversation at your GCPL Branch

Geauga County – July 20, 2017 – The Geauga County Public Library has seen a lot of growth since 1963, and as community needs change, we continue to evolve to serve patrons. This Nov. 7, we are reaching out to voters to help us fund capital improvements across all our facilities. We are putting a half-mill bond issue on the ballot. This costs Geauga homeowners of a \$100,000 house approximately \$16 per year. That's less than the equivalent of many hard-bound bestselling books at Amazon or Barnes & Noble.

About the Geauga County Public Library

The Geauga County Public Library includes four full-service branches in Bainbridge, Chardon, Chesterland (Geauga West) and Middlefield; two library stations housed in schools in Newbury and Thompson; two Bookmobiles that serve rural areas and community centers; a Lobby Stop vehicle; a car for homebound patrons; and an administrative center where technical services, computer services, facilities and administrative functions reside. GCPL has more than 750,000 books and ebooks. The collection also contains more than 100,000 audio / video items and 400 research databases available through its website.
