Foundation Directory Online offers access to grants and other funding opportunities for our nonprofit and small business community. Grants to Individuals is a database that offers the smartest, fastest way to find scholarships, fellowships and awards for students, artists, researchers, and individuals. Both of these databases are accessible inside our Bainbridge Branch only, during all regular hours of operation.

About the Geauga County Public Library

The Geauga County Public Library includes four full-service Branches in Bainbridge, Chardon, Chesterland (Gauga West) and Middlefield, two library stations housed in schools in Newbury and Thompson, and a Mobile Services fleet that serves rural areas and community centers. Its administrative center is located in Chardon, where technical services, computer services, facilities and administrative functions reside, along with a full-service public library space with limited hours of service (Monday – Friday only). GCPL houses more than 750,000 books and digital books. The collection also contains nearly 70,000 audio / video items. About 75 research databases are available via its website.
