Clarence Bozeman has taught high school in Alabama and Ohio. He has participated in civil rights demonstrations in Alabama. He has lectured at churches, colleges, and universities on the history of the civil rights movement and Dr. Martin Luther King's life and legacy. He earned his Bachelor's degree from Alabama State University, where he majored in American History and Social Studies. He received his Master's in Education Administration from Fordham University in New York City, as well as an Educational Specialist Degree from Cleveland State.

### **About the Geauga County Public Library**

The Geauga County Public Library includes four full-service Branches in Bainbridge, Chardon, Chesterland (Gauga West) and Middlefield, two library stations housed in schools in Newbury and Thompson, and a Mobile Services fleet that serves rural areas and community centers. Its Administrative Center is located in Chardon, where technical services, computer services, facilities and administrative functions reside, along with a full-service public library space with limited hours of service (Monday – Friday only). GCPL houses more than 750,000 books and digital books. The collection also contains nearly 70,000 audio / video items. About 75 research databases are available via its website.
