You are cordially invited to attend the Geauga County Library Foundation's first non-event on Friday October 23, the Stay at Home and Read Fundraiser.

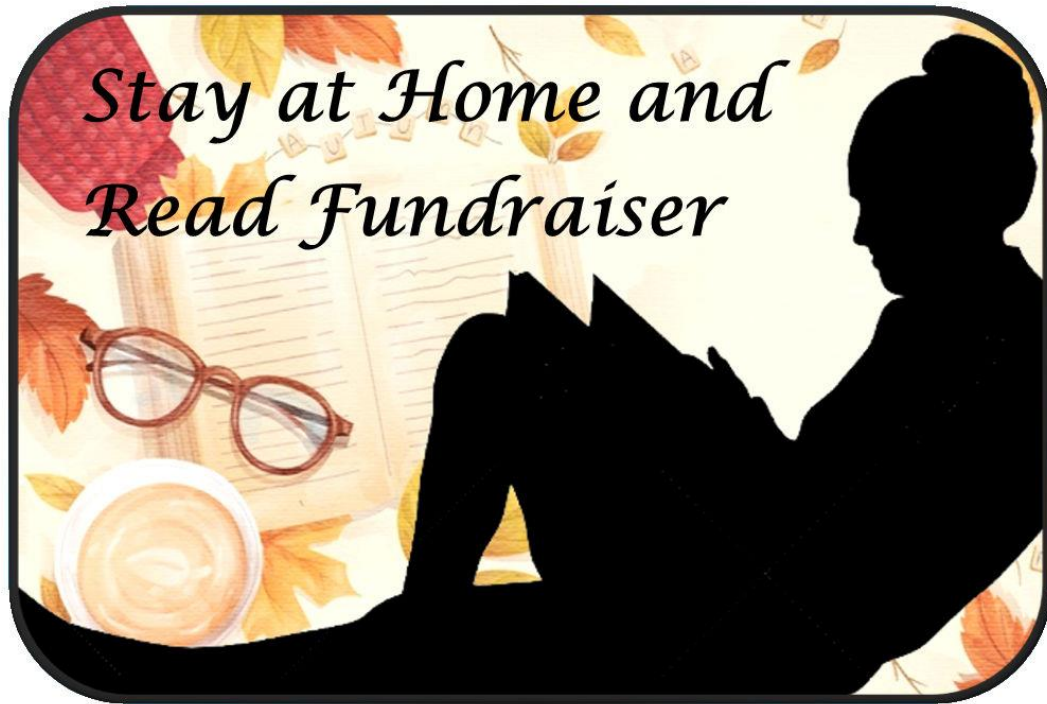

The Geauga County Public Library includes four full-service branches in Bainbridge, Chardon, Chesterland (Gauga West) and Middlefield; one library Station housed in the former Ledgemont School in Thompson; a fleet of Mobile Services vehicles that serve rural areas and community centers; and an Administrative Center where technical services, computer services, facilities and administrative functions reside. GCPL has more than 900,000 books and ebooks. The collection also contains more than 100,000 audio / video items and 60 Research databases available through its website.
