What is a Maker Space?

A maker space is a resource where patrons can use different specific equipment to explore, design, and create.

Equipment Available

The following equipment is available for patrons:

- 3D Printer
- 3D Scanner
- Cricut Maker
- Embroidery Machine
- Heat Press
- Large Format Printer
- Laser Engraver
- Sewing Machines
- Sublimation Printer
- Vinyl Cutter

When can I use the Maker Space?

The Maker Space is currently unavailable as we get it ready for you. GCPL is hoping to start training sessions this summer. To use the Maker Space, you must be trained on each individual machine— according to your interests— first. Then you will schedule sessions with the Bainbridge Reference staff.

Cost

Using the equipment is free. You will bring in your own materials as much as possible such as T-shirts, hats, paper, Cricut vinyl, wood, glass, etc. You will only have to pay for ink, large vinyl, embroidery thread, and 3D printer filament. There will be a \$1 minimum for every machine. Check out the Price List in the Maker Space for more information.
